

Minutes of the Emmaus Board Meeting
January 20, 2002 6:30 PM

Lay Director Tom Waldrop called the meeting to order and presented a devotion on Isaiah 58:3.

Steve Abell asked that receipts for food donations for fall walks be prepared for Bluegrass Restaurant. A motion was made by Ruthie McQuady and seconded by Lynda Cochrum to authorize Steve Abell to sell donated kitchen equipment for \$500.00.

IRS letters for the years 1997-98 has been received signifying there is no claim against the Emmaus Community.

A list of potential lay directors will be available at the February board meeting. Pray and discussion will be held for these names with a vote to be taken in March.

A joint Emmaus/Chrysalis board meeting was discussed. Dates for future board meetings were set as follows: February 7th; March 7th; April 14th Sunday @3:30 PM; June 6th; June 30th Paducah (Chrysalis) 6:30 PM (Pending need); August 1st; September 22nd First Christian Church, Murray, 3:30 PM; November 7th, Tommy Waldrop's Home 7 PM; and December 7, Gathering at BASIC, Board meets at 6 PM.

Community gatherings were also announced with places of some gatherings to be announced at a later date: February 2nd – Bethel Christian Church; March 2nd; April walks – candlelight; May 4th; June 1st – Picnic; July – Chrysalis Flight June 29-July 1, candlelight; August 3rd; September walks; October walks; OCTOBER 12 TRAINING AND GATHERING; November 2nd; and December 7th – Christmas Gathering at BASIC.

Lay Director reports indicated that team selection meetings have been held and that process is going well. A discussion began on having a board representative at each walk. It was suggested to review manuals and guidelines from The Upper Room and to continue the discussion of what and how this should be handled.

Discussion was held on the policy for rolling pilgrims names over and over on the walk list. Lynda Cochrum moved that effective fall walks if a person on the list has been ask twice and not attended a walk a letter will be sent to the sponsor to see if they are still interested in participating in the Walk to Emmaus. Seconded by Donna Shelton.

Spiritual Director, Bro. Eulas Greer is compiling a list of spiritual directors and will discuss the guidelines for serving as a spiritual director at the February board meeting. It was recommended that the Spiritual Director for each walk notify the community Spiritual Director when pastors participate in the Walk to Emmaus. The board was reminded the importance of pilgrims attending the training sessions and completing their volunteer sheets.

The domain name has been renewed through July 2004. The board voted to reimburse Keith Maness for the fee.

New co-chairs of the kitchen are Jonathon Frensley and Greg Godby.

The meeting was adjourned in pray.
