

Purchase Area Walk to Emmaus Board Minutes

We are still in need of a new worship chair.

After prayer the Lay Directors for Walks 79 & 80 were selected with back up choices.

The nominating committee to select candidates for serving as Board Members and Community Spiritual Director met earlier in the evening. Debbie & Keith will be contacting the ones on the list to see if they will allow their names to be submitted to run.

Eddie McGregor sent word that we are officially called the Purchase Area Fourth Day Community with our tax-exempt # B-21444.

New Business:

Current number of pilgrims for each walk was discussed. Mike asked permission to move someone to an ALD position. It was reported that the team meetings had gone well.

Board decided to purchase 6 dozen new battery candles to sell at Candlelight for that purpose.

A carpet is needed for the snack agape area.

The number of chairs we have for the conference room was discussed. It was decided to purchase 8 new tables (light weight 8 ft. tables from Sam's Club) Keith will take care of this purchase. They are to be marked with Emmaus and 2004.
