Please pray for Amy and for Mike as they lead their teams over the weekend. Please pray for each pilgrim that God might meet them in new and deeper ways over the weekend.

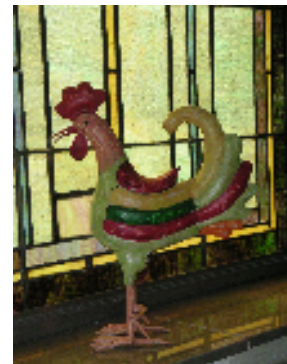
Please remember how good it is to experience the unconditional love of God. Let's practice this over the weekend and every day.
